

CIC panel Meeting 30th Sept 05

Minutes from previous meeting were accepted as a true record.

GB confirmed that he cannot run the November 2005 revalidation but CR has agreed to do so.

CR reported from Training Committee that the weather & flooding booklet was discussed and that he would liase with D Banes as to best way forward. Funding was available.

NB voiced a concern about people attending CIC Training Courses that were inappropriate for their ability. The general feeling was that things were perceived as being ok but perhaps more screening of course members should be done at the application stage: perhaps a self evaluation sheet of personal ability (skills) should be circulated before hand,

CR gave out a booklet on course assessment plans and guidance notes. These were discussed in depth. NB thought that there should be a greater emphasis on assessing the approach and pedagogy of the instructor and their awareness of teaching progressions and learning styles.

It was thought appropriate to get a guest speaker at an ACI workshop to discuss skill acquisition.

NB raised that he had received a request to join the CIC Panel. It suggested there could be a new status of a trainer only. This should be put to the Training Committee. TF suggested, that number of T/A should be kept at 8.

GB announced that he will be stepping down from the CIC Panel as from when his CIC award expires
